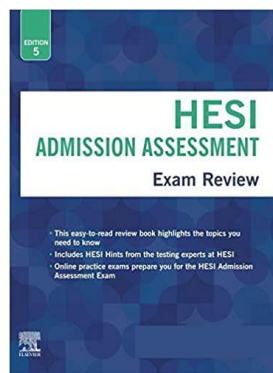

The test consists of three subjects:

- Grammar
- Math
- Reading Comprehension

- The HESI exam will be two and a half hours long with 165 questions.
- To be considered for admission into the Education program, you must score:
 - A minimum score of **50%** is required to be considered in the application ranking process for the program.
 - Candidates must pay a \$65 non-refundable testing fee for each attempt.
 - Candidates are allowed two (2) attempts per testing cycle.
 - Candidates may reschedule exams attempts at least one day (24 hours) in advance.
 - Failure to call for a reschedule will mark candidates are No-Call/No-Show (fee will be non-refundable) candidate must pay again to reschedule

Prior the testing day, please provide your Admissions representative with the following items:

- Required Testing Fee
- High school diploma or its equivalency

WHAT TO KNOW ON TESTING DAY

1. Candidates should arrive at least 15 minutes before their exams.
2. Candidates will be required to show proof of payment.
3. Present Drive License or State Issued ID
4. All candidates' personal belongings will be stored in our secure lockers located outside of the testing center.
5. Candidates will be provided with scratch paper, pencils, ear plugs, noise cancelling head phones and quiet and inviting testing environment.

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6. The examinees will have 2.5 hours to complete the HESI entrance exam and will be tested over 3 subjects: Reading comprehension, Math, and Grammar (55 questions per section).
7. The HESI does not allow for flagging of questions and there is no back button. Testers must be sure of their answers before moving on because they will not be allowed to return to any completed questions.
8. Those who fail to return to the previously paused sections to complete them will receive zero credit for those questions left blank.
9. The HESI exam contains an embedded calculator and time clock.
10. Bathroom breaks are allowed, but candidates must go one at a time (wait for candidates to return before the next person can go).
11. The HESI exam is scored by taking the average of scores of the 3 completed sections (Please see required minimum score for admission consideration referenced on pg. 1)
12. Candidates are offered 2 chances to score the minimum requirement for admission before they must wait until the next testing cycle for a new opportunity.
13. HESI Scores are good for 1 year. If the candidate is accepted into the program but declines their seat for any starting cohort within the testing year, they will have to retake the HESI exam again should they wish to reapply.
